SUMMER 2010 FINANCIAL AID CHECKLIST

1. **Apply for admission to JCJC.**
 All applicants must meet admission requirements to receive financial assistance. (Students must be admitted and currently enrolled in a degree-granting or certificate program at JCJC.)
2. **Apply for the 2009 - 2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before the June 30, deadline date. PLEASE READ ALL STEPS BEFORE APPLYING ONLINE.**
Step 1 -
 If you do not have a FAFSA on the Web Pre-Application Worksheet, download the worksheet at www.studentaid.ed.gov, then print the worksheet.
Step 2 -
 Completely fill out the worksheet based on 2008 tax documents.
Step 3 -
 Apply for a Personal Identification Number (PIN) at www.pin.ed.gov. The PIN can be used subsequent years.
All students must obtain a PIN. In addition, if the student answers "No" to all the questions in Section 2 on the pre-application worksheet, one parent must also obtain a PIN.
Two options to receive PIN:
 1. **E-mail (up to 2 days)**
 Print the email when opening the document the first time.
 2. **U.S. Mail (7 to 10 days)**
Step 4 -
 Complete the online FAFSA application at www.fafsa.gov. Include JCJC's school code - 002411.
3. **Waiting period.**
 The federal processor sends results to JCJC if the school code is listed on the FAFSA. A Student Aid Report (SAR) is also emailed to the student within 2 days (if applied online). However, if the student completed and mailed a paper application, allow 4-6 weeks to receive the SAR.
4. **Respond promptly to the JCJC Financial Aid Office (FAO).** If additional information is needed, the student will receive a letter from the FAO indicating the item(s) needed. Submit requested information as soon as possible.
5. **Check/View financial aid status.**
 Students can log in the JCPortal to view current financial aid status. (Step 1 must be completed to check financial aid status.)
6. **To determine if a file is complete.**
 An award notification letter stating the type of aid and amount awarded will be mailed to the student. The student should sign and return one copy to the FAO accepting or declining the award.
7. **Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).** Students receiving any form of financial aid from JCJC will be expected to maintain SAP toward their degree objective.
8. **Returning Students.**
 If the student did not apply for the 2009 - 2010 FAFSA, read and follow Steps 1 - 7. Then, complete Step 8. If a FAFSA for 2009 - 2010 was previously submitted with JCJC's school code, DO NOT REAPPLY. See below.
 - Complete and submit a Summer 2010 Request for Financial Aid application by July 9, 2010. **Please read carefully Section E of the application.**
9. **Transfer Students.**
 If the student did not apply for the 2009-2010 FAFSA, read and follow Steps 1-7. Then, complete Step 9. If a FAFSA for 2009-2010 was previously submitted for another school, add JCJC's school code (002411) to the SAR. See below.
 - Complete and submit a Summer 2010 Request for Financial Aid application by July 9, 2010. **Please read carefully Section E of the application.**

Transfer students are not eligible for summer aid at JCJC unless they are admitted and enrolled for the upcoming academic year. **Transfer students attending JCJC for summer only are not eligible for financial aid.**
10. **Guest/Transient Students.**
 If admitted as a guest/transient student, the student will not be eligible to receive financial aid at JCJC.

E. Students must meet admission requirements before financial aid can be awarded.

Students receiving aid from the **first** scheduled pell award, enrollment hours may vary. (Full-time, ¾, ½, or less than ½ time)

Students seeking a **second** scheduled pell award, must enroll and complete a minimum of six (6) credit hours.

Students interested in student loans for summer, must also complete a JCJC summer loan application. **Summer loan applications will be available April 2010.** Students who receive student loans must be enrolled in at least six hours at the time of disbursement. If the student borrowed the maximum loan amount during the fall and spring, the student will not be eligible for a summer Stafford loan.

*Summer financial aid will be based on your enrollment at the time your application is reviewed. **A change in summer enrollment may result in the loss of all or a portion of student aid eligibility.** Check with the FAO before making any enrollment changes.

Students must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to be eligible for summer aid. Even though a student may be awarded financial aid for summer, the student may become ineligible if SAP is not met at the end of the spring semester.

Students can check the JCPortal for summer awards beginning May 7, 2010. However, an award letter stating the type and amount of aid will be mailed to the student.

If you plan to attend JCJC during Fall 2010, complete a 2010-2011 FAFSA and submit all paperwork by May 3, 2010.
